BY CAR

Life Conference and Banqueting in Newcastle, is appropriately situated one mile from the A1(M), the main route between the UK capital cities of London and Edinburgh. We have over 400 secure car parking spaces available to conference delegates.

BY TRAIN

Life Conference and Banqueting is just 200 yards from Newcastle's Central Station which has passenger rail connections to all of the UK's main cities and towns. The Metro underground system also runs through this station with trains running every few minutes to points around Newcastle and the locality.

BY AIR

Newcastle International Airport is a seven mile drive from the city centre and has connecting and scheduled flights to most UK and international airports. Taxi and car hire services are available from both the train station and the airport.
