**THE ASSOCIATION OF ANAESTHETISTS
REGISTRARS' PRIZE 2010**

This competition offers trainees the opportunity to present original papers at the GAT Annual Scientific Meeting in Cardiff in July 2010. Entrants must be members of the Association of the Anaesthetists of Great Britain and Ireland who have held a post approved as part of a training programme in anaesthesia by the Royal College of Anaesthetists or the College of Anaesthetists of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland during the year preceding the closing date. Anyone who has taken up a permanent post as a Consultant in the National Health Service (or its equivalent) shall not be eligible.

Entrants must supply an abstract of not more than 250 words and state whether or not any part of the work has been presented, submitted or published elsewhere. Abstracts should be double-spaced and should conform to the style requirements of the Notice to Contributors published in *Anaesthesia*. Full contact details should be included in the body of the email.

After the closing date all abstracts will be peer reviewed. Shortlisted candidates will be asked to give an oral presentation at the meeting lasting no longer than 10 minutes.

The winner is awarded the President's Medal and a cash prize. In addition, runner-up prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
