

Senior Lecturer To be seconded to the University of Zambia



THET is seeking to recruit a **volunteer Senior Lecturer in Anaesthesia** who will be seconded to the School of Medicine, University of Zambia. The post holder will be part of the teaching team at the School of Medicine and will therefore contribute to curriculum development and teaching on both postgraduate and undergraduate courses. He/she may be asked on occasion to teach specialist modules in other health professional courses e.g. for medical licentiates and clinical officers.

The successful applicant will be registered in the UK as a medical practitioner with a CCT in Anaesthesia and on the Specialist Register with the GMC. He/she will possess the ability to teach or manage teaching up to master's level, and be willing and able to travel to and reside in Zambia for a period of three years.

The post holder will receive a fixed departure grant to help cover relocation costs, as well as a monthly stipend to cover living expenses whilst in Zambia.

This position is only open to applicants with the right to live and work in the UK.
