Articles and letters should be submitted, together with any declaration of interest, to the Editor, care of the Association of Anaesthetists as an email attachment in Microsoft Word English (UK). If this is not possible, please supply copy on disk, to The Association of Anaesthetists, 21 Portland Place, London, W1B 1PY.

Please do not send digital images, figures or photos unless they are at least 300dpi in resolution. Preferable file formats are JPEG or PDF.

Author's full name, position/ grade and hospital must be included and a contact address, telephone number and email.

Articles should not normally exceed 1500 words (including any references, further reading, tables, figures or graphs). Each table, figure or graph should have a title. It is the author's responsibility to obtain written permission for the use of any copyrighted material.

The Editor of *Anaesthesia News*, Dr Hilary Aitken, reserves the right to edit articles for reasons of space or clarity.

Please note that due to the volume of correspondence received, letters will not normally be acknowledged.
