## Dr Philip Michael Bewley



I am delighted to write this citation for my friend Phil Bewley. Phil was elected to the Trainees Committee in 2014, and stepped down in 2017. Following which, he spent the next 18 months in Australia completing both a trauma anaesthesia fellowship at the Alfred hospital in Melbourne and a pre-hospital medicine fellowship with the Sydney Helicopter Emergency Medical Service.
